**AN ORDINANCE** to create the Garden District Local Historic District and granting the Historic District Landmarks Commission jurisdiction over new construction, demolition, and demolition by neglect of all properties bounded by the lake side of Magazine Street, the downriver side of Delachaise Street, Carondelet Street (both sides), and Jackson Avenue (both sides); and otherwise to provide with respect thereto.

**WHEREAS**, consideration of the Historic Preservation Study Committee's Report was initiated by the Garden District Study Committee and the Historic District Landmarks Commission and referred to the City Planning Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Planning Commission held a public hearing on this petition and recommended approval in its report to the City Council, dated May 11, 2007;

**WHEREAS**, the recommendation of the City Planning Commission was upheld and the changes were deemed necessary and in the best interest of the City and were approved by Motion Number M-07-265 of the Council of the City of New Orleans on June 7, 2007.

**SECTION 1. THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS HEREBY**

**ORDAINS** that the creation of the Garden District Local Historic District is approved and jurisdiction over construction, demolition, and demolition by neglect is granted to the Historic District Landmarks Commission in the area generally bounded by the lake side of Magazine Street, the downriver side of Delachaise Street, Carondelet Street (both sides), and Jackson

6 Avenue (both sides); in accordance with Motion M-07-265 of the Council of the City of New  
7 Orleans.

1 **SECTION 2.** Whoever does anything prohibited by this Ordinance or fails to do  
2 anything required to be done by this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon  
3 conviction shall be subject to a fine or to imprisonment or both, such fine and/or imprisonment  
4 set by Section 1-13 of the 1995 Code of the City of New Orleans, or shall alternatively be subject  
5 to whatever civil liabilities, penalties or remedies the law may prescribe. Conviction shall be the  
6 cause for the immediate cancellation of the Use and Occupancy permit of the premises.


